Tips for Time Outside of Rehearsals

We encourage parents and guardians to check in with their children.

- Do they know all their lines? Do they need help practicing their lines and reviewing their blocking?
- Stay hydrated! Theaters tend to be a bit dry—drink lots of water throughout the week.
- Get rest. No great performance is done when you are tired. Make sure to go to bed early and take care of your body.

If you can arrive early to get into costume, we recommend arriving no earlier than 9:00 a.m. • Please bring lots of snacks and water to stay fueled. • We will have breaks throughout the day—actors can bring their meal or have it dropped off at MoCo’s front desk in between rehearsals and shows (1:30 p.m. or 5:30 p.m.). • This will be a very long day, and it is important to be ready to work hard and focus—please bring your patience!

Costumes

Please bring in all the requested costume pieces on Thursday, 4/2. This way, if anything is missing, we can help look for the remaining costume pieces. Our costumer has talked to the actors and told them all what they should be bringing.

- All actors should come with loose-fitting clothing that is easy to remove from Thursday through Saturday.
- We recommend that actors wear light-colored leotards or something close-fitting that they can wear comfortably under their costumes. This makes changing costumes faster and easier. Please let us know immediately if you do not have something that will work.
- **If you are playing a male role**, please bring in white tights and black dress shoes/character shoes.

Hair/Makeup

We will have minimal time to apply stage makeup and style hair; therefore, any preparation at home would be appreciated. Female characters should have hair curled or in a braided updo. Male characters should have hair slicked back, parted, or in a low ponytail. Pictures of hair and makeup styles will be added to the resources folder over the weekend.
